DIY Seed Tape

Materials

2 ply Toilet Paper

Seeds - small seeds such as carrot, lettuce or radish

Flour and water

Toothpicks



Method

- 1. Break off a length of toilet paper (½ a metre works well).
- 2. Carefully fold in half long ways.
- 3. Mix the flour and water together in a bowl until it makes a sticky paste. Make sure it is not super thick.
- 4. Dab small amount of flour paste in the middle of the paper. Use a toothpick to make sure the glue is placed evenly apart.
- 5. Get two seeds and carefully place them in the flour paste. Continue doing this until you reach the end of the toilet paper.
- 6. Fold the toilet paper in half lengthways to cover the seeds inside the paper.
- 7. Allow the seed tape to dry, then roll it up.

Don't forget to label your tape!
